

NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

Pursuant to section 286.011, Florida Statutes, notice is hereby given that the Okaloosa County Special Selection Committee (the "Selection Committee") will convene for a public meeting on Thursday, May 28, 2020, at 11:00 A.M. CST at the Okaloosa County Administration Building, located at 1250 N. Eglin Parkway, Shalimar, Florida 32579, for a meeting to discuss and hear presentations related to ITN PS 01-20 EMS Billing Services as well as make recommendations related to the procurement.

Pursuant to Section 286.0113(2)(b)1 and 2, Florida Statutes, portions of the meeting at which the vendors will be making oral presentations and answering questions as part of the competitive solicitation to the Selection Committee will be exempt from the public meeting. Those permitted to be present during such portions of the meeting are: the Selection Committee Members, County Staff, Members of the County Attorneys Office as well as a court reporter to ensure a complete recording of the meeting shall be made. The presentations are anticipated to take place between 11:00 a.m. and 3:45 p.m. CST. After presentations have concluded, the public portion of the Selection Committee meeting will resume, at approximately 3:50 p.m. CST or soon thereafter, for final discussion and action by the Selection Committee.
