- 7. When responding to the required elements of this RFP, shall the contractor's responses be put in an addendum format, and limited to forty pages, excluding the required forms? It can be put in any format that the contractor prefers. It is limited to 40 pages excluding the required forms.
- 8. SAM.gov is a typically required of vendors interested in contracting with the Federal government. Registration is a highly unusual requirement for County governments. Please confirm Sam.gov registration is required for this RFP. It is not required if the county is not using Federal Funds, however, we do encourage all vendors to be registered. It is free of charge to all vendors.
